Jones, Cardale

COLLEGE

Played in 23 games for the Buckeyes and was a perfect, 11-0, as the starting quarterback for the best winning percentage for a QB in school history with 10-or-more starts. Included in his victories are three of the most important wins in school history; post-2014 season conquests of Wisconsin in the Big Ten title game, No. 1 Alabama in the College Football Playoff semifinals at the Allstate Sugar Bowl, and No. 2 Oregon in the national championship game. He was the MVP of the Big Ten title game after throwing for 257 yards and three touchdowns. He threw for 2,323 yards with 15 touchdowns, seven interceptions and a 61.9 completion percentage for his career.

2015: Started eight of the 10 games he appeared in during the 2015 season...completed 110 of his 176 pass attempts for 1,460 yards, eight touchdowns and five interceptions.

2014: Jones started in three games total and appeared in 10 on the year...he completed 56 of his 92 pass attempts for 860 yards, seven touchdowns and two interceptions...Jones stepped in to the starting lineup after J.T Barrett was hurt against Michigan...all combined, Jones threw for 742 yards and five touchdowns and rushed for 90 yards and one score in Ohio State's three-game post-season.

2013: Played a total of 39 plays from scrimmage in games vs. Florida A&M, Penn State and Purdue ... only attempted one pass in those three games that Ohio State won by a collective score of 195-14, but did rush 17 times for 128 yards (a 7.5 per carry average) and scored one touchdown

2012: Redshirted.

PERSONAL

Was nominated for an ESPY in the "breakout" player category ... rated by Rivals.com as the No. 12 prep school player in the country in 2011 ... led perennial northeast Ohio high school power Cleveland Glenville to a 24-3 record as a starting quarterback ... attended high school at the Ginn Academy.
